FOREWORD

By the far-seeing generosity of Miss Phyllis J. Walker, and in commemoration of her uncle the late Howard Carter, the Griffith Institute in 1946 received the manuscript and photographic records of Tut'ankhamūn's tomb made by him and his collaborators during their excavation of the tomb in the years from 1922 to 1931.

Up to the present time historical factors have opposed insuperable obstacles to the publication of any comprehensive catalogue of Tut'ankhamūn's tomb, that almost fabulous treasure being, of course, the property of the Egyptian Republic and preserved in the Egyptian Museum at Cairo.

As the excavation of the tomb proceeded Howard Carter made meticulous notes on each object, written on cards in his own hand with scholarly precision. These cards are now preserved, with drawings and transcriptions of many technical and epigraphic details, in the archives of the Griffith Institute; they constitute source material for study of the tomb second in importance only to the objects themselves. Photographs taken at the same time by Mr. Harry Burton of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York further cover all the most important objects in the collection.

The present handlist and index are intended as a concise statement of the contents and guide to the documentation of the tomb as recorded by Howard Carter. The list retains the excavator's original numbering of the objects and the wording of his descriptions modified only by such small changes as have been required to secure consistency in terminology and in the transliteration of Egyptian words. The items are annotated to show where Carter's notes are amplified by drawings or sketches, or supported by transcriptions of hieroglyphics. It may be added that for many if not most objects some technical note by A. Lucas is included in the record. Bibliographical references have been limited to the plates in Howard Carter and A. C. Mace, *The Tomb of Tut.ankh.Amen*, a full bibliography being included in Porter and Moss, *Topographical Bibliography of Ancient Egyptian Hieroglyphic Texts, Reliefs, and Paintings*, Volume i, second edition, Part 2, at present in the press. It has been thought best to omit all reference to the numeration of objects in the Cairo Museum on which neither completeness nor reliability could be achieved.

The work of preparing the handlist and index was undertaken by Mrs. Mary Nuttall and Miss Helen Murray, to both of whom the Committee of Management desires to express its warm thanks, as it does to Dr. J. R. Harris for much practical help and advice. It is hoped that the present work will serve not only for convenient reference by scholars drawn to Tut'ankhamūn's tomb as a source of first-hand material, but also as a preliminary step towards an eventual systematic publication of the treasure itself.
