Provisional list of officials Carter was dealing with:

Using the documentation in the Tutankhamun Archive enables us to reconstruct a list of Egyptian officials connected with Howard Carter and the Tutankhamun excavation. This list is not comprehensive.

- **H.E. Saleh Enan Pasha Under-Secretary of State to the Ministry of Public Works**; he appears in the 1925 mummy-examination committee and in Carter's record of the official party.
- **H.E. Sayed Fuad Bey el Kholi**, Governor of the Province of Keneh, which matches Carter's "Mudir of Keneh".
- **Tewfik Effendi Boulos**, Inspector of the Service des Antiquités Inspector; then after 1924, the Chief Inspector of the Service des Antiquités. Carter refers to him as Chief Inspector of Antiquities for Upper Egypt / Chief Inspector Luxor in the journals.
- **Ibrahim Effendi Habbeeb**, Inspector of Antiquities, Luxor.
- **Girgis Effendi Elias**, Inspector of Luxor and Keneh.
- **Mohamed Riad Bey**, a member of the government commission; Carter identifies him as being from the Legal Department, P.W. Ministry.
- **Mohamed Effendi Shaban** and **Hamed Effendi Suliman**, named as representatives of the Egyptian government who were at the examination of Tutankhamun's body, which took place in November 1925.
- **Saleh Hamdi Bey (Mohamed Saleh Hamdi)**, a medical doctor who later became Undersecretary of State, adjunct to the Ministry of Public Hygiene; Hamdi played a central role during the examination of Tutankhamun's body in November 1925.
- **"the Bey the Marmour of Luxor"**, a later journal names that Luxor official as **Ahmed Tewfik Mouro (of Luxor)**, which strongly suggests the same officeholder.
- **Pierre Lacau**, the Director of the of the Service des Antiquités Inspector and was present at the 1925 examination of Tutankhamun's body.
